To have and to hold the said easements unto said Shell Pipe Line Corporation, its successors and assigns, so long as such structures are maintained. Upon the cessation or maintenance of such structures, the easement or easements hereby created shall cease and determine.

And by the acceptance hereof the grantee agrees to bury such pipe lines so that they will not interfere with the cultivation of the land, and also to pay any and all damages to crops, fences, buildings, timber and land which may be suffered from the construction, operation or maintenance of such pipe lines.
