Dear Ms. Exnicios:

We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 1 July 2013 and two copies of the above-referenced report. We have completed our review of this report and have no comments to offer.

We concur that site 16PC110 is undetermined with respect to its eligibility for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places, and that sites 16PC111, 16PC112, 16PC113, 16PC114, 16PC115, and 16PC116 are not eligible for nomination to the National Register. As site 16PC110 now lies outside of the proposed project area, no archaeological historic properties will be impacted by this project.

In reference to historic standing structures, we concur with your evaluation that the three surveyed structures (38-00837, 38-00838, and 38-00839) are not eligible for listing in the National Register.
